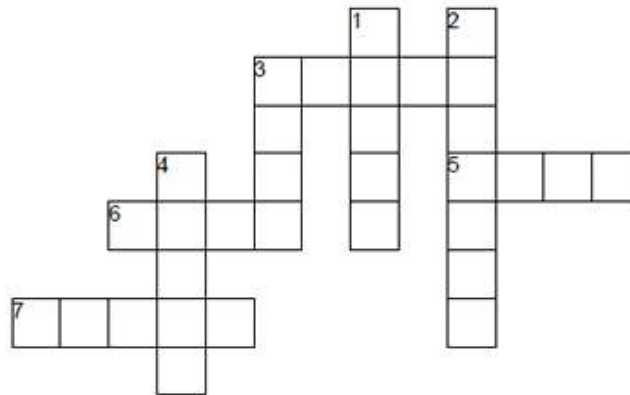


# Jesus Anointed with Perfume
