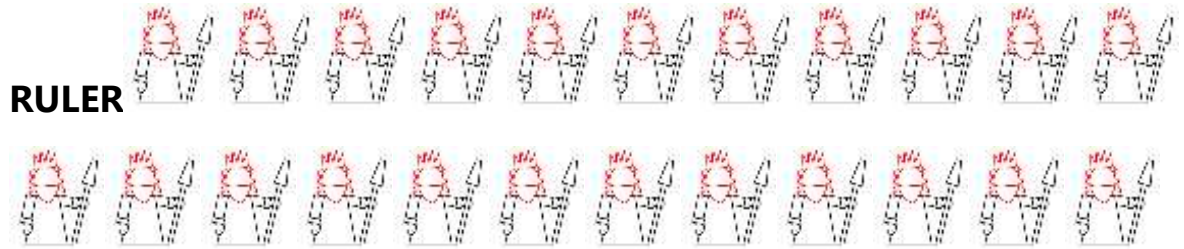

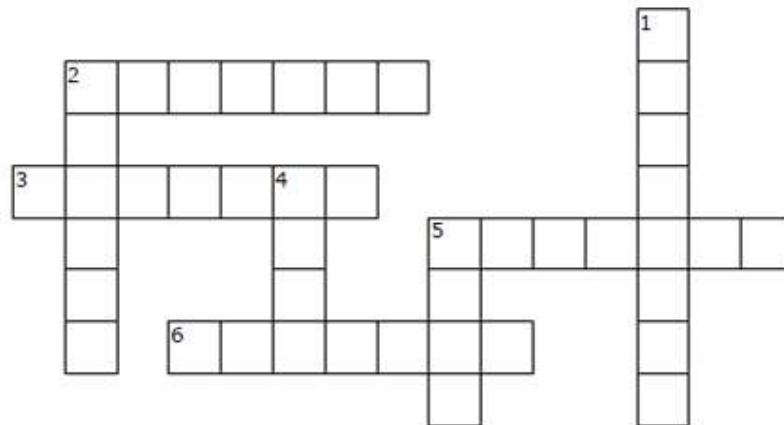


Christ the King
